

# BERICHTE VON FEBRUAR 2023 REPORTS FROM FEBRUARY 2023

## BERICHT FEBRUAR

Im Februar setzten die Schulgruppen ihre Arbeit wie im Januar in Kabul und Maidan Wardak fort. Aufgrund der Sicherheitslage wurden die beiden Schulgruppen in Parwan geschlossen, aber gleichzeitig wurden zwei weitere Gruppen, eine in Maidan Wardak und eine in Helmand, organisiert. Die Anzahl der Schülerinnen blieb bei den Gruppen in Kabul und Maidan Wardak fast gleich wie im Januar.

Die neue Gruppe in Maidan Wardak umfasst 23 Schülerinnen, die von 13:00 bis 16:00 Uhr in den Fächern Chemie, Physik, Mathematik und Englisch unterrichtet wurden. Die Gruppe in Helmand wurden denselben Fächern wie Maidan Wardak Gruppe unterrichtet, mit 15 Schülerinnen von 14:00 – 17:30.

Die Schulgruppen legen detaillierte Berichte von ihrer Arbeit vor, unten wurde als beispiel von beiden Gruppen aus Kabul die Berichte zusammengefasst:

### KABUL

- Im Englischunterricht haben wir unseren Schülern bei drei Kapiteln der Grammatik (Grammar) geholfen, die von Frau Dawlati<sup>1</sup> gedruckt und den Schülern zur Verfügung gestellt wurden.
- Im Englischunterricht haben die Schüler der siebten Klasse "Let's Go Two" abgeschlossen und "Let's Go Three" begonnen.<sup>2</sup>
- Im Englischunterricht haben wir neben dem Lehrbuch auch an der Verbesserung anderer Fähigkeiten wie z.B. der Präsentation in englischer Sprache gearbeitet, und dieser Trend wird fortgesetzt.
- Um die Qualität des Unterrichts zu verbessern, insbesondere für Schülerinnen mit Schwierigkeiten, wurden Gespräche mit den Eltern durchgeführt, was sich als hilfreich erwiesen hat.
- Um die Schreibfähigkeiten der Schülerinnen zu weiterentwickeln, haben sie zusätzlich zum Lehrbuch auch Aufsätze und Geschichten verfasst, und glücklicherweise waren die Ergebnisse sehr gut, und dieser Trend wird fortgesetzt.
- In diesem Monat wurden die Schüler motiviert, Briefe zu schreiben, um ihre Anliegen und Wünsche zu formulieren, was sich als sehr fruchtbar erwies.
- Bei den Fächern wie Mathematik und Physik wurden zusätzlich zu den Vorlesungsnotizen des Lehrers, wurden auch mit den Lehrbüchern von Bildung Ministerium<sup>3</sup> gearbeitet.
- Zur Stärkung der englischen Sprachkenntnisse wurden die Fächer Mathematik, Physik und Chemie bis zu einem gewissen Grad bilingual (in zwei Sprachen) unterrichtet.<sup>4</sup>

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- Die Lektionen dieses Monats wurden entsprechend dem geplanten Zeitplan durchgeführt (es ist jedoch möglich, dass einige Lese-Kapitel früher abgeschlossen werden).

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**REPORT FEBRUARY (EN)**

In February, the school groups continued their work as in January in Kabul and Maidan Wardak. Due to the security concerns, the two groups in Parwan were closed, but at the same time two other groups were organized, one in Maidan Wardak and one in Helmand. The number of students remained almost the same for the groups in Kabul and Maidan Wardak as in January.

The new group in Maidan Wardak includes 23 female students who are taught chemistry, physics, mathematics as well as English from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm. The group in Helmand is taught the same subjects as Maidan Wardak group, with 15 students from 14:00 - 17:30.

The school groups submit detailed reports of their work, below is a summary of the reports of both groups from Kabul as an example:

- In the English lessons, we assisted our students with three grammar chapters that were printed and provided to them by Mrs. Dawlati.<sup>5</sup>
- In the English lessons, the seventh-grade students completed "Let's Go Two" and started "Let's Go Three."<sup>6</sup>
- In addition to the textbook, we worked on improving other skills such as presenting in the English language, and this trend will continue.
- To enhance the quality of teaching, especially for students facing difficulties, discussions were held with parents, which proved to be helpful.
- To further develop the writing skills of the students, they wrote short essays and stories, in addition to the textbook! Fortunately, the results were very good, and this trend will continue.
- This month, students were motivated to write letters to express their concerns and articulate their wishes, which proved to be very fruitful.
- In subjects such as Mathematics and Physics, in addition to the teacher's lecture notes we used textbooks from the Ministry of Education.<sup>7</sup>
- To strengthen English language proficiency, Mathematics, Physics, and Chemistry subjects were taught bilingually to some extent.<sup>8</sup>
- The lessons of this month were conducted according to the planned schedule (although it is possible that some reading chapters may be completed earlier).
